

ATUPA PROGRAM

Adolescent Tobacco Underage Prevention Act

The Health Department utilizes student workers under the age of 21 to assist in our ATUPA program. The student workers are paired with a team of experienced Sanitarians to conduct stings for the purpose of ensuring compliance with laws restricting the purchase of cigarettes and other tobacco products to minors.

As students are only eligible to participate in this program until the day prior to their 21st birthday, we have an ongoing need for eligible hourly student workers to replace those that age out in order to meet the grant deliverables.
